- Fails to properly conduct prenatal tests
- Fails to properly conduct labor
- Does not safely monitor a mother during pregnancy
- Misdiagnoses or fails to diagnose prenatal conditions
- Fails to treat prenatal conditions
- Improperly prescribes medication
- Fails to determine umbilical cord complications
- Fails to treat or prevent an infection
- Improperly uses forceps
- Performs a medical error during neonatal care
- Behaves negligently resulting in injury to a patient

#### **OB/GYN medical malpractice can occur:**

- In a obstetrical clinic
- In an emergency room
- In a delivery ward
- Over the phone or via virtual correspondence

- OB/GYNs
- Gynecological staff
- Hospitals
- Obstetrical clinics
- Medical malpractice insurers
